### **Pawnee, Vegetation Fire, Lake County**

Location: Pawnee Rd. x New Long Valley Rd., 4 miles NE of Clear Lake Oaks Jurisdiction: State DPA, SRA, Sonoma,-Lake-Napa Unit Per Cal OES Duty Officers and ICS-209, as of 06/25/18 at 0851 hours:

- 8,200 acres grass and oak woodland, 0% contained
- Expected containment: 07/01/18
- 500 residences and 100 minor structures threatened
- 12 residences and 10 minor structures destroyed
- Continued threat to 230kV power lines
- Continued threat to critical fiber optic infrastructure
- Threat to Indian Valley reservoir Hydroelectric Plant
- CAL FIRE IMT-3 assigned

### **Activations:**

- Cal OES Coastal Region EOC is activated to Level III.
- Lake County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) activated at Level 3 as of 06/25/18 at 0700 hours.

### **Proclamations**

- On 06/24/18 at 0904 hours, a Proclamation of Local Emergency was received as a result of the incident. There are no requests for assistance.

### **Deployments**

- 1 Cal OES Fire and Rescue Branch Assistant Chief
- 1 Cal OES Coastal Region Emergency Services Coordinator assigned as of 1100 hours, 06/24/18
- 1 Cal OES PSC Technician assigned
- On 06/23/18 at 2138 hours, a Fire Management Assistance Grant (FMAG) Request was received by Cal OES from the Incident.
- The request was approved and forwarded to FEMA.

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**Evacuations**

- Mandatory Evacuation Order in effect for Spring Valley Lakes Community which includes all roads accessed off of Old Long Valley Rd. and New Long Valley Rd., north of Highway 20. Also, includes Mule Skinner, Long Branch, Watertrough Rd., Flintlock, Muzzleloader, No Guns, Antelope, Cougar, Marianne, Ramrod, and Moccasin

**Evacuation Shelter**

- Lower Lake High School, 9430 Lake St., Lower Lake, CA
- Midnight Population: 16
- Animal shelter plan has been activated

**Road Closures**

- New Long Valley Rd. is closed at Highway 20
- Old Long Valley Rd. is closed at Highway 20

**Critical Infrastructure**

- Per CUEA as of 06/24/18 at 1024 hours, no reported cable outages at this time. The grid is currently stable and the fire is not impacting the grid.
- Per the PG&E Online Outage Center as of 06/24/18 at 2136 hours, 504 customers are without power. Estimated restoration: 06/25/18 at 1800
